The CATRA Open Schooling Shows are for all experienced and inexperienced riders, made or green horses. The focus of this Horse Show is to offer many different types of classes to competitors of many different abilities. The various classes offer new and accomplished riders fantastic challenges in types of classes that they have never tried, practice in the familiar classes, and fun for all! There are 5 different areas for the classes to be held: Main arena, Dressage Arena, Trail Course, Cones Course, and Driving Course. There is a judge for each area. **There is no horse show in the US that offers so much for so many levels!**

The CATRA Schooling Show benefits The Capital Area Therapeutic Riding Association located in Grantville, PA. CATRA is a non-profit organization which is a quality Therapeutic Horseback Riding Program for people who are physically and/or mentally challenged. It is located in the Grantville, PA area. Ribbons and Awards



1. **Class ribbons will be awarded through 8th Place.** Participant ribbons will be awarded in **some** classes.
2. **Champion & Reserve & Bronze metals** will be awarded for each Division.
3. **Overall Show Champion & Reserve & Bronze(for the day)** will be awarded.
4. **Series Championships** –Gold, Silver, Bronze given only to those attending **both** shows.

You may choose from **ONE** of the following groups. Look for the X in the line under your choice. That is what you are allowed to enter. You cannot cross enter with or without another horse.

1. Assisted, for people of any age who need assistance while participating.
2. Walk/Trot 12 & Under, for people under 13 who don't canter or lope.
3. Walk/Trot 13 & Over, for people over 12 who don't canter or lope.
4. Advanced, for people of any age who can canter or lope.

Rules: Please Read!!

- **Dressage tests** are available at www.catra.net or at the secretary's stand. Tests may be read without penalty. Attire may be English or Western.
- **You may download an entry form on line at catra.net and fill it out and turn it in at the show.**
- **Assisted Division** - Rider may be assisted by a leader and/or one or two side-walkers, or a driver in class #15 & #26 with an extra set of reins which the assistant holds. **Assistant on the ground must be next to horse and rider within 3'.**
- **Competitors must go into classes in Ring 1 as they are called.** Classes in Ring 2 & 3 must **not** conflict with Ring 1.
- May be done at competitor's convenience. **Do NOT wait until the last minute!** All **MUST** be completed by times indicated on program. **Please watch your time. NO REFUND for missing a class.**
- **Please pay close attention to classes that can be entered in particular divisions.** Point tabulating is being done by computer. Classes are limited by skill and age. Cross-entering is not permitted. **Schooling without being judged is not permitted in any division.**
- **No schooling allowed over jumps in main arena. A practice jump is provided in the field.**
- **"Open" (advanced)competitors may not enter walk/trot classes or assisted classes.**
- **Points** given to rider number and name of rider combined **except in Mini division** in which points go to name of Miniature Horse. **The number stays with same rider the entire show day. May switch horses within the same division with number but not switch divisions. May not borrow another persons number to show another horse.**
- **Tack and attire** may be either English or Western in Walk/Trot, Dressage, Trail, Cones, Driving, and In-hand events.
- **Helmets must be worn** in all over fences classes, in assisted games classes, and by riders under 19 in unassisted games.
- **Trail championship candidates must perform in a Cones Course Class.**
- **Dressage Walk/Trot Pas de Deux:** Two riders will design and perform a 3-5 minute pattern which includes mirrored 20m circles from "X" at the trot. May use music.
- **Dressage Line Driving:** all horses, ponies, minis. **Driver to walk beside, not directly behind.**
- **Cart Driving** – Assisted may have 2 sets of lines. Assisted **Must** have two people in the cart.
- **Stallions or colts may not be shown by anyone under 18,** in accordance with 4-H guidelines.
- **Pair Division:** Points are awarded to the **Rider1&Horse1/Rider2&Horse2** combo. **Do not change partners for series championships.**
- **To maximize points for division, do not change partners or horses in any pair classes.**
- **If you did not get a ribbon, please come ask for a participation ribbon at the secretary's stand.**
- **Questions may be addressed to the show management, not to the judge!**
- **In-hand classes are open to any ridden or non-ridden horse. Minis entered in mini classes cannot enter In-hand.**
- **To qualify for Series Championships you must attend both July 2nd and August 6th shows.**
- **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.** -Registration is being accepted the day of the show.
